Robinson's Nickels for Nails Fundraiser

Yesterday we kicked off our newest fundraiser, "Nickels for Nails", which will run through Friday, February 1st. By collecting our spare change and dollars, we will be buying the nails and other building supplies for a deserving family's new home. Each class will have a jar to collect nickels located in front of the school office. You may put in as many nickels as you wish. At the end of each day, we will count the nickels and post the scores. One nickel equals one point. To gain an advantage on the competition, you can knock down other classroom scores by adding paper money or other coins greater than a nickel to their jars. Paper money and more valuable coins will decrease points in a jar. For example, if a jar contains 1,000 nickels and someone puts in a \$5 dollar bill, 100 points would be subtracted from that jar. A quarter would subtract 5 points from a jar. Let's have fun and raise some money while we're at it! Questions?
